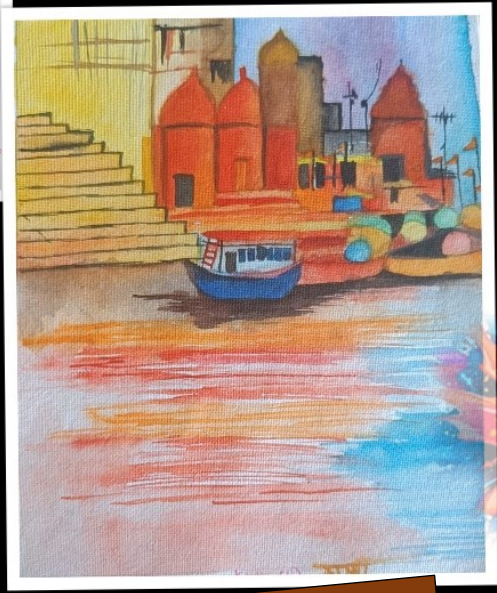

Digital Wisdom

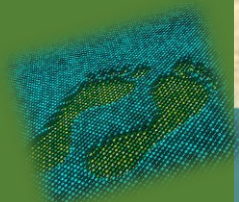
In the digital realm, we roam and play,
