Principal, **Mrs. Rekha Nair** commended the sincere efforts of the students and teachers for orchestrating such a thoughtful and striking celebration.

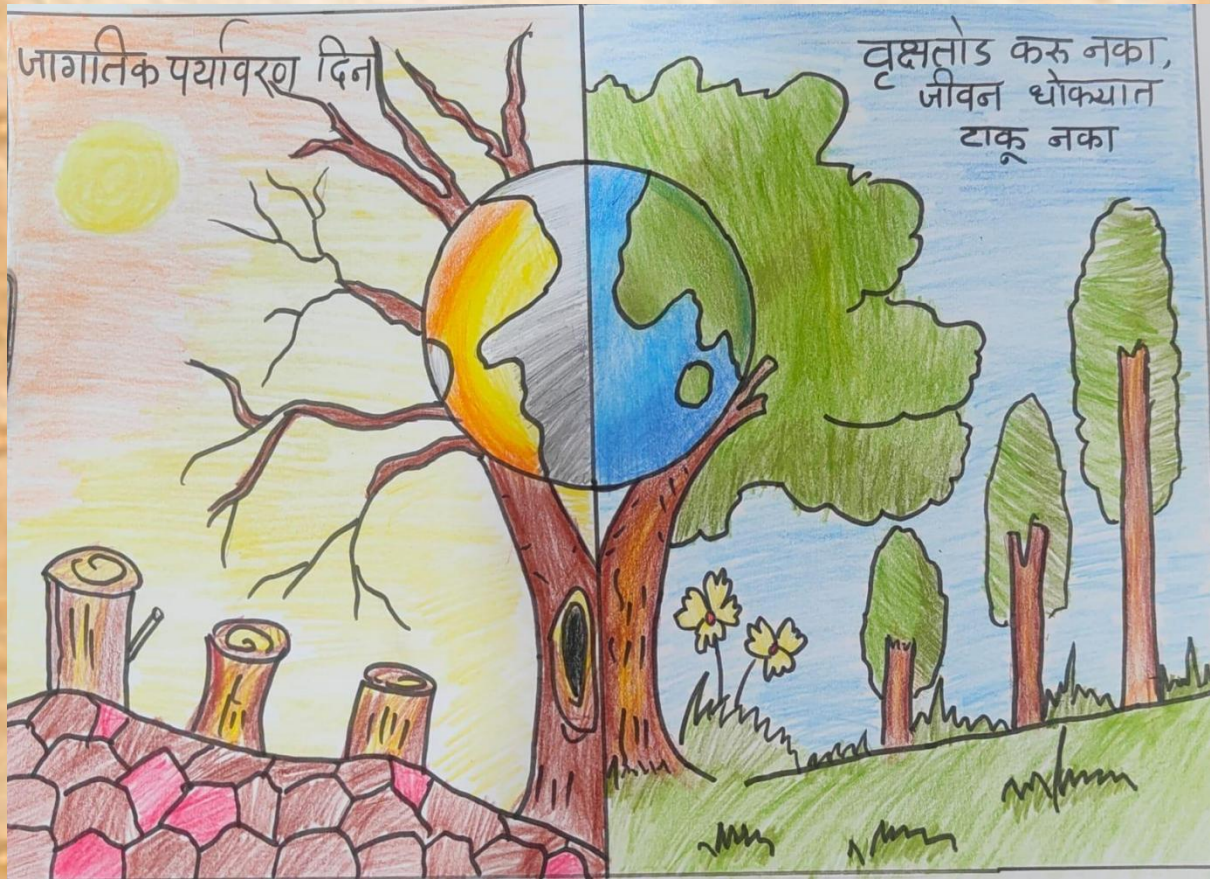


Young Changemakers Inspire Action for a Greener Future

How Chess Keeps Me Sane: My Journey of Seven Years

Writing this as I sit here reflecting on the past seven years of my life, one thing becomes crystal clear: chess has been my haven. I'm in the IX grade, but for more than half my life, it has been a constant - this game of 64 squares. I started playing chess when I was a tender 7-year-old. It has, ever since, been a lifesaver that keeps me grounded, focussed, and most importantly, sane.

• My Chess Journey

When I learned the rules of chess at the tender age of 7, it was a world which intrigued and baffled me. It seemed pretty straightforward the way pieces moved on the board, pawns simply advance, bishops by diagonal slanting moves, knights by their weird L-leap, and queens with omnipotent power in all directions. But beneath that apparent simplicity, there existed an ocean of strategic depth, creativity, and patience. I soon found out that chess was not just a game but a mental exercise, a battle of ideas and foresight.



I lost far more games than I won, when I first began, but every single loss was a lesson in itself. Chess teaches that in every case, mistakes are inevitable, but growth opportunities lie at every step. Every time I lost, I was eager to examine what went wrong, trace my steps, and avoid making the same mistake again. It was one cycle of continuous self-improvement, and not just in chess, but it was also redoing my life paradigm in ways. Chess taught patience, critical thinking, and best of all, how to learn from failure.

• How Chess Keeps Me Sane

Being in the VIII grade can be pretty stressful at times. With academically intense pressure to perform, maintaining friendship circles, and all the roller-coaster emotional drama that comes with being an adolescent, it can be pretty easy to get overwhelmed. Chess is my escape from that noise. When I sit down to play, be it against a friend, online, or against the computer-I enter this completely focussed state. Everything around me fades away; all that exists is the chessboard.



Chess offers control in an otherwise chaotic world. We can never predict what life will bring, but in chess, everything is planned in advance. Chess is a place where strategy and planning beat everything else, thinking through a decision, sometimes changing the outcome of a game. That's an incredible feeling of control, really relieving me from stress, while focussing on what really matters, by being calm in difficult situations.

But, more importantly perhaps, chess is my meditation. Sometimes, playing places you in the moment. So much of my concentration goes into trying to work out the problems and decide what the other player is going to do next. This absorption helps block out distraction and worry. It's a clear mind that can be carried into other parts of my life.

THE VALUE OF CREATING A PROFILE

Academic achievement alone is no longer sufficient for students to stand out in the quickly changing academic environment of today. As a psychology instructor and school counsellor, I have seen firsthand how profile building can enable students to reach their greatest potential and get ready for a prosperous future.



Profile Building: What Is It?



The process of creating a comprehensive portfolio that highlights a student's abilities, passions, accomplishments, and experiences outside the classroom is known as profile building. This covers involvement in leadership positions, extra-curricular activities, community service, internships, workshops, and more. Developing a thorough picture of the student's identity both within and outside the classroom is the aim.

What Makes Creating a Profile Crucial?

Growing Competition: As more and more students attain high academic standing, colleges and employers are seeking applicants who can contribute in ways other than grades. In a competitive pool, students who have a strong profile stand out.

Holistic Development:

Creating a profile encourages students to learn new skills, pursue a variety of interests, and mature as people. It cultivates traits like problem-solving, communication, teamwork, and leadership.



Passion and Commitment:

To highlight in applications and interviews, maintain a record of all your accomplishments, honours, and certifications.



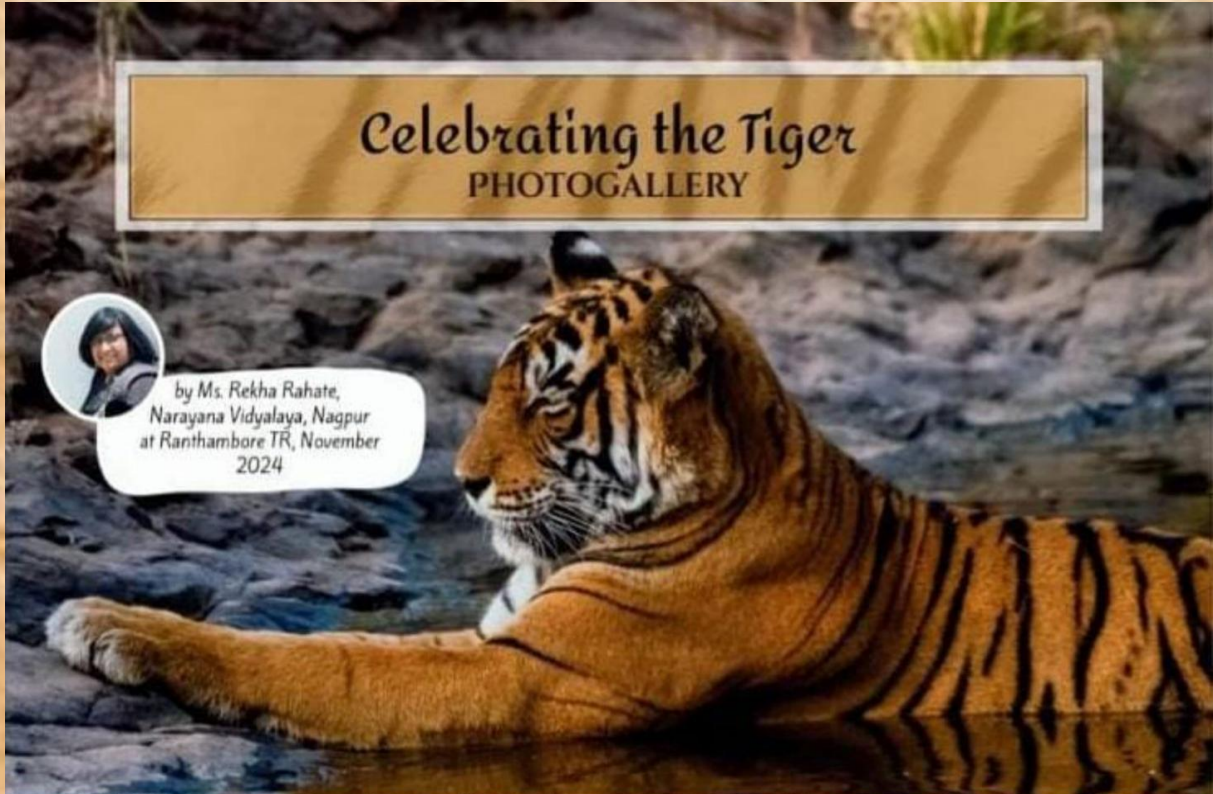
In conclusion
