



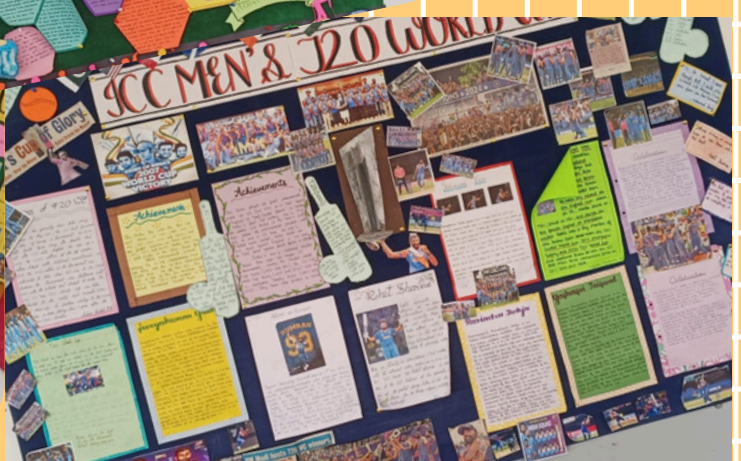
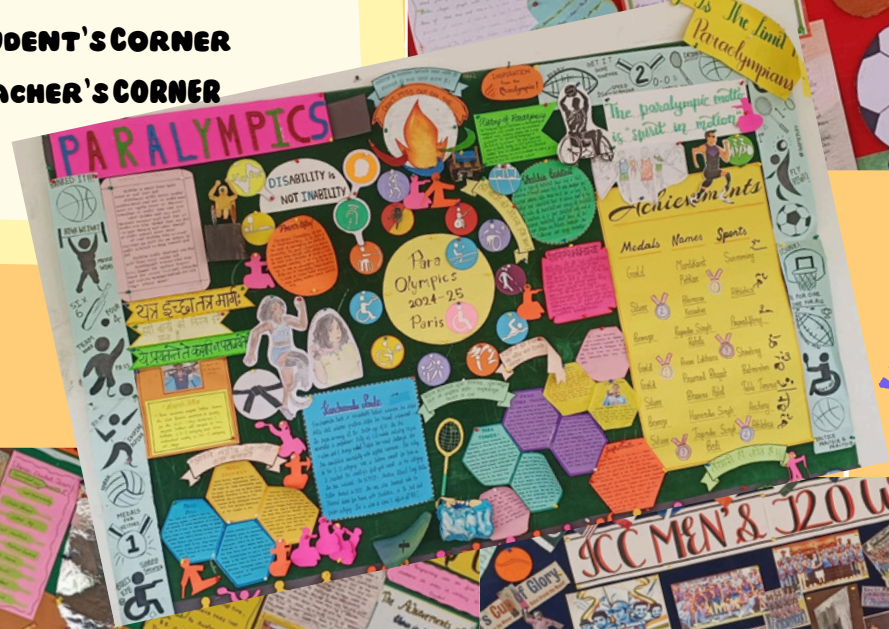

- Grade IX: Students wrote the biography of Indian classical dancer Mahuwa Shankar, which enhanced their thinking skills.



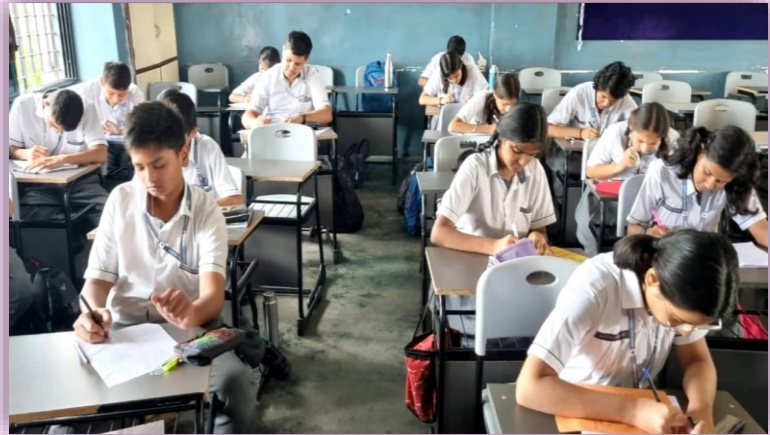


### Literary Club:

### Science Club

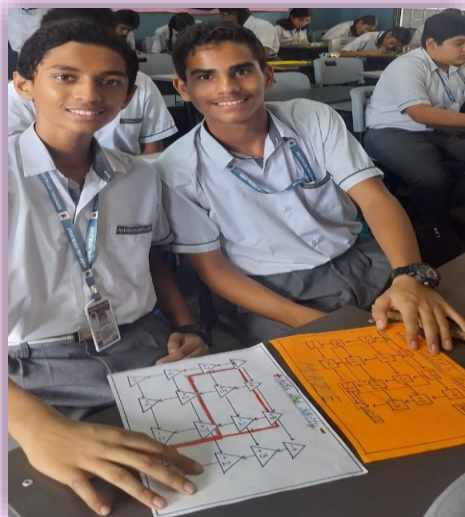

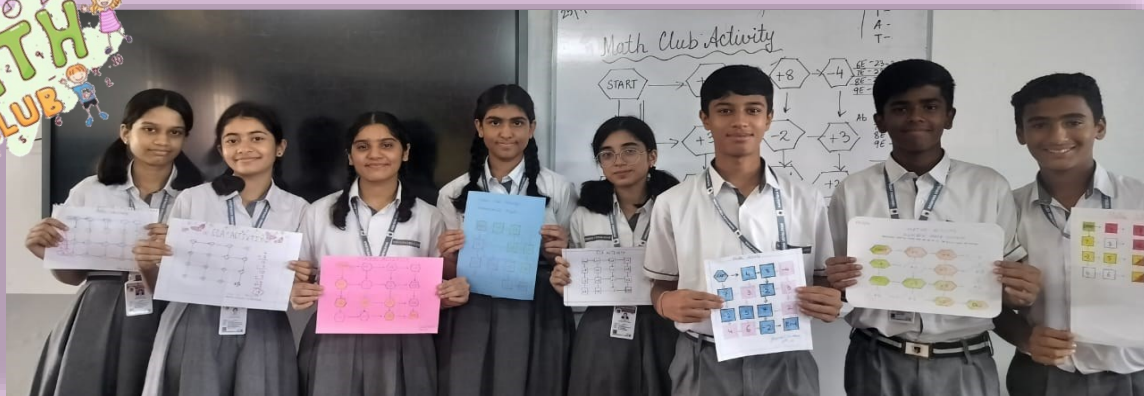


### Math Club

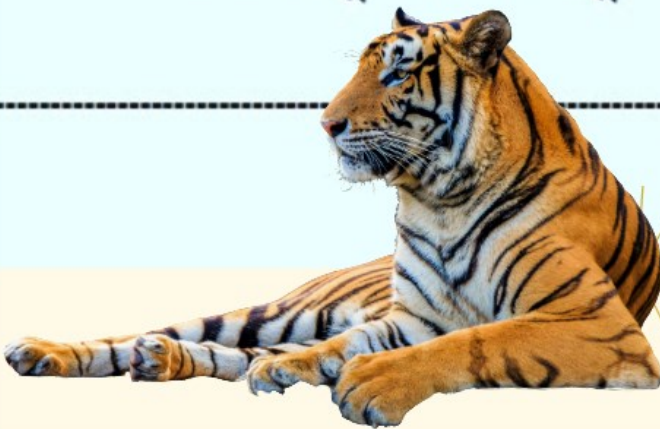
